Curbside Yard Waste Collection Continues

All yard waste except tree, bush or brush materials are to be placed in biodegradable paper yard waste bags with a maximum weight of forty pounds and set near the street curb in front of the residence during the yard waste disposal dates for collection and disposal by the city. NO GARBAGE CONTAINERS, PLASTIC BAGS OR CARDBOARD BOXES WILL BE ALLOWED. All tree, bush and brush materials are to be bundled and tied in maximum lengths of four feet with a maximum weight of forty pounds and set near the street curb in front of the residence. To assure prompt pick-up, please place your yard waste at the curb by 7 a.m.

Tree Maintenance Regulations

According to City of Perry Code of Ordinances, Chapter 151, the property owner of the abutting property shall keep the trees on, or overhanging, the street trimmed so as to allow free passage of pedestrians and vehicular travel, and so they will not obstruct or shade the street

lights, the vision of traffic signs or the view of any street intersection. All branches **must be at least thirteen (13) feet above the surface of the street and nine (9) feet above** the sidewalks. Planting restrictions and species of trees/ shrubs planted within the parking (area between the curb and sidewalk) is regulated by Chapter 151. Please contact the City of Perry at 515-465-2481 prior to planting any trees within the parking.

Park Shelter Rentals at Pattee and Wiese Parks

Individuals are able to reserve the shelters at Pattee and Wiese Parks from April 1st to September 30th each year.

The big shelter at Pattee Park and the shelter and gazebo at Wiese Park are \$50. The two small shelters at Pattee Park are \$20 for a weekend reservation or \$10 per time slot during the week.

Alcohol permits are available to be purchased for an extra \$25 fee with at least a 2 week notice. Photo ID is required and the applicant must be able to pass a background check. No children may be present.

Online Payments and Card Payments at Perry City Hall

Perry residents are able to make online or in-person card payments at Perry City Hall. The City of Perry, through Forte, offers a quick and easy payment option for customers interested in paying their extra garbage bill, rental inspection invoice, cemetery space payment or other city payments by credit or debit card or electronic check. Forte is a third party automated payment processor that accepts MasterCard, Visa,

Discover and Electronic Check payments 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Payments can be made in any amount. Forte will charge a convenience fee for each transaction. The fee covers payment handling and processing charges. The City of Perry does not receive any portion of the service charge. If you stop into City Hall to pay in person by credit or debit card, the processing fee is waived.
